## Procedures for Student Identification Cards

Students will be issued one Identification Card every year. If a student forgets his/her I.D. card, a temporary card will be issued for that day by the Main Office. The student is responsible for the replacement fee that will be paid directly to Joseph's Photography which is located at 168 Chestnut Street in Nutley. A \$5.00 replacement fee will be charged. The student will be disciplined up to and including suspension. The discipline for students who lost their I.D. card is as follows:

First Offense	-	Warning
Second Offense	-	Vice Principal's Detention
Third Offense	-	Central Detention
Fourth Offense	-	2 Central Detentions
Fifth Offense	-	Saturday Detention
Sixth Offense	-	Suspension
Beyond the Sixth Offense	-	Discipline- Administrative Discretion
Any Defacing/Damage to School Issued I.D. or Temporary I.D.	-	2 Central Detentions
Not displaying I.D. Cards Per Board of Education Policy	-	Discipline- Administrative Discretion
Failure to Report to Office for Missing or Forgotten I.D. Card	-	Discipline- Administrative Discretion
Wearing Another Student's I.D.	-	Discipline- Administrative Discretion
Wearing a Different Year's I.D.	-	Discipline- Administrative Discretion

## **5517 PUPIL IDENTIFICATION CARDS**

The Board of Education recognizes school building security measures are important for the safety and welfare of all pupils, staff, parents and community members in school buildings. In recognizing this important responsibility, the Board requires all pupils to carry school district issued identification cards to be visible at all times while in school. Pupils who fail to do so may be disciplined up to and including suspension.

The school district will provide Identification Cards to be issued to all pupils in the middle school, and the high school, and may be presented for:

1. Identification at school district activities on school district property other than the school attended by the pupil;
2. Admission to school dances and other school-related activities;
3. Identification for library media services to include library book, periodical and other resource checkout;
4. Entrance for Scholastic Aptitude Tests, State Standardized Tests and other testing programs administered on school district property;
5. Identification for transportation services offered by the district including the use of activity buses;
6. Identification for admission to certain school-related and school district sponsored functions; and
7. Other purposes and activities as determined by the Building Principal.

Pupils will be issued one card(s) every year. If a pupil forgets his/her ID card a temporary card will be issued for that day by the main office. A replacement fee will be charged, at the cost equal to the reproduction cost, for all lost identification cards.
